

## **NCWC RESOLUTION CRITERIA**

A Resolution should adhere to the following criteria:

1. It is national in scope.
2. There is not similar policy already on the books.
3. The Whereas Clauses clearly define the problem and set out the facts to be corrected by the Resolved Clauses.
4. The first Resolved Clause is a statement of proposed NCWC policy.
5. The Resolved Clauses are worded so that they can stand on their own.
6. There is background material to support all the Whereas Clauses.
7. The background material is from credible Canadian sources, not newspaper articles unless the reporter has done the research, and is recent.
8. Preferably there are no more than 5 Whereas Clauses.
9. The title clearly defines the content of the resolution.
10. There is a proposed action plan for the resolution.
